Things got especially interactive during the hands-on try-out of the TE_REG tool. Working side by side with local participants, the team gathered valuable feedback. The tool was praised as reflective, inspiring, and full of potential for curriculum development. At the same time, participants didn’t hold back on constructive suggestions—calling for clearer guidance, simpler language, less complexity, and strong facilitation to support its use.
